Responsibilities for exam papers

The National Aerospace NDT Board of Austria, a Committee of the Austrian Society of Non-destructive Testing (ÖGfZP) and accepted in May 2005 by the National Authority (Austro Control) has agreed upon statements mentioned below:

In general, training and examination for level 1, 2, and 3 (common methods according to ÖNORM EN 4179/NAS 410) will be performed at authorized outside agencies.

Outside agencies must be stated in the written practice of the employer.

For training and examination authorized outside agencies in Austria are:

Level 1 and 2

- ARGE VASL (MT, PT, ET, IRT, UT, RT-Film)
- ARGE TÜV AUSTRIA Akademie GmbH und TPA KKS GmbH (MT, PT, UT, RT-Film)
- ÖGI - Österreichisches Gießerei-Institut (RT-NonFilm)

Level 3

- ARGE QS3-Ausbildung (UT, RT, MT, PT, ET)

For reasons of data protection, only the following certificates will be delivered to the employer:

- Training certificate, including source, type of training, dates of training and course hours
- Certificate with the results in percentage of the general, specific and the practical examination.
- Certificate issued by the Austrian Society of Non-destructive Testing (ÖGfZP)

Further information on the detailed results of the single parts of the examinations, like questionnaires, checklists for preparing a NDT-procedure or the execution of a practical examination will be available for inspection by the employer's customers or for audits of NANDTB and/or external agencies. All records will be serviced by the cognizant outside agency.

Under no circumstances, the employer shall have access to the questions for general and specific examination, except those specific questions provided by the employer.
